

Mammals

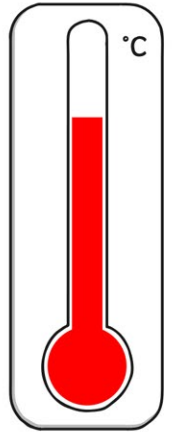
Are **warm** blooded.

Amphibians

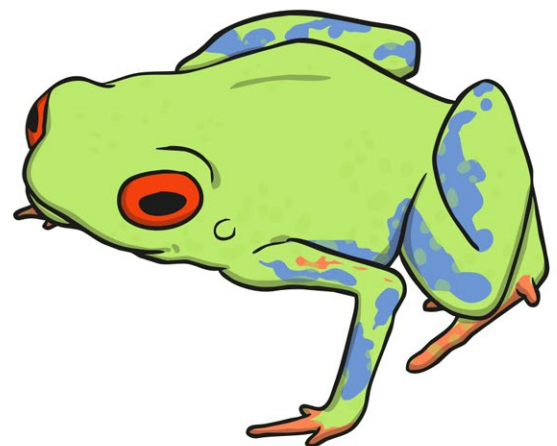
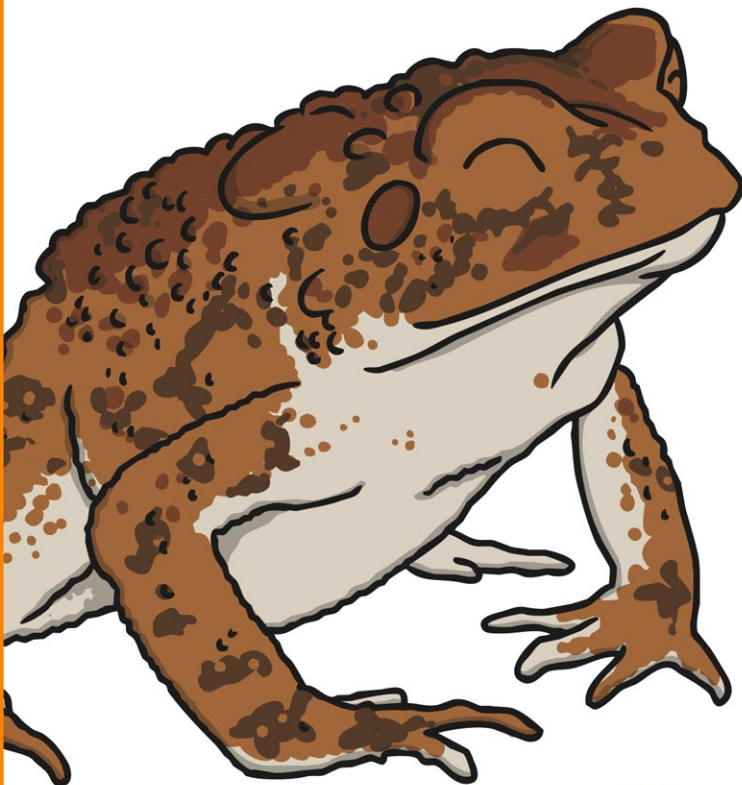
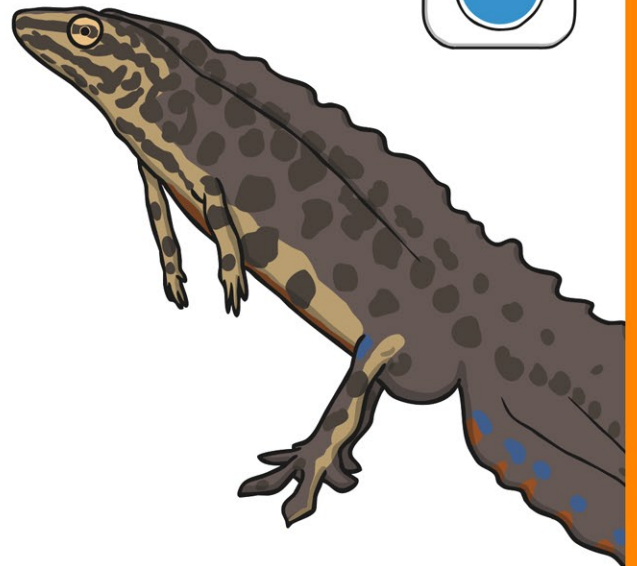
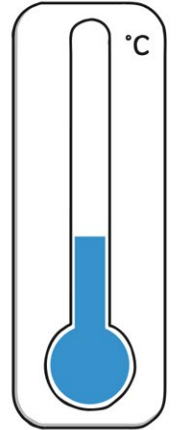
Are cold blooded.

Reptiles

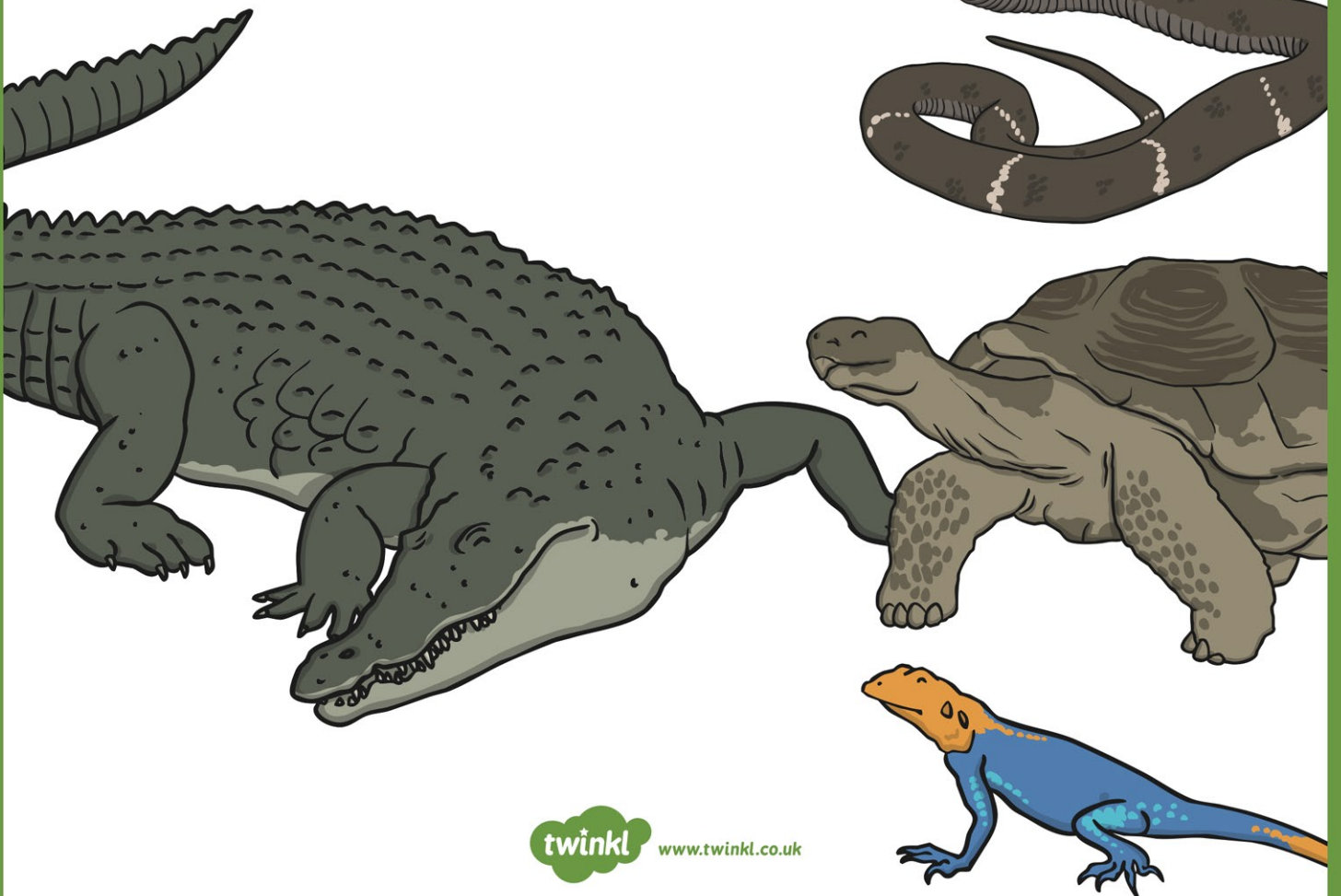
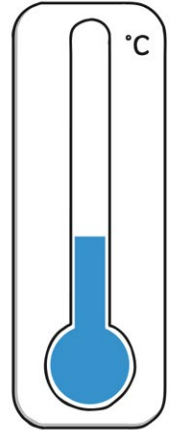
Are **cold** blooded.

Fish

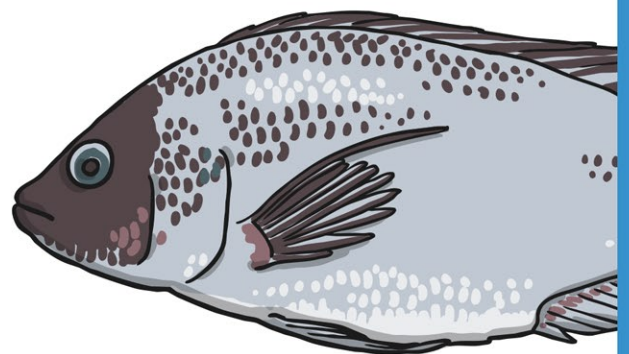
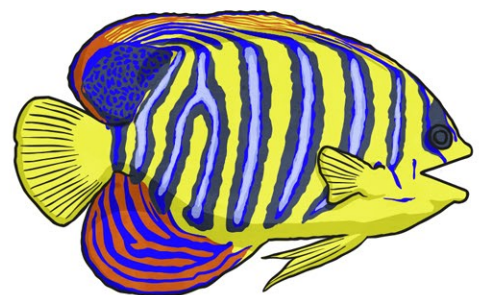
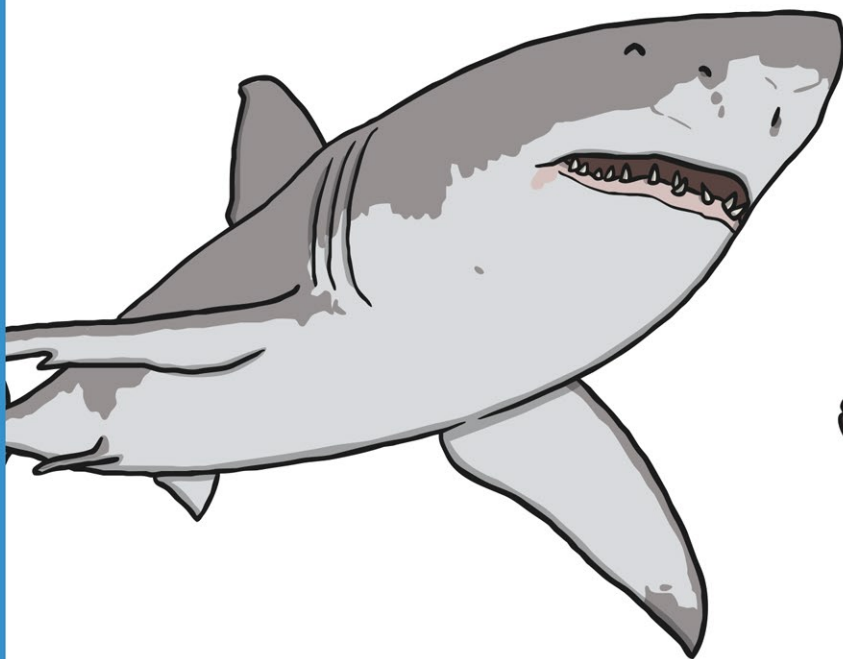
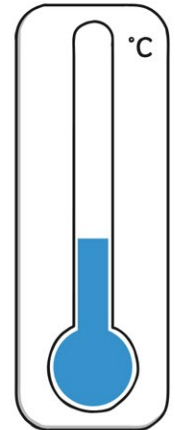
Are cold blooded.

Birds

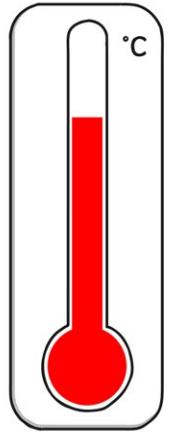
Are **warm** blooded.

Are cold blooded.

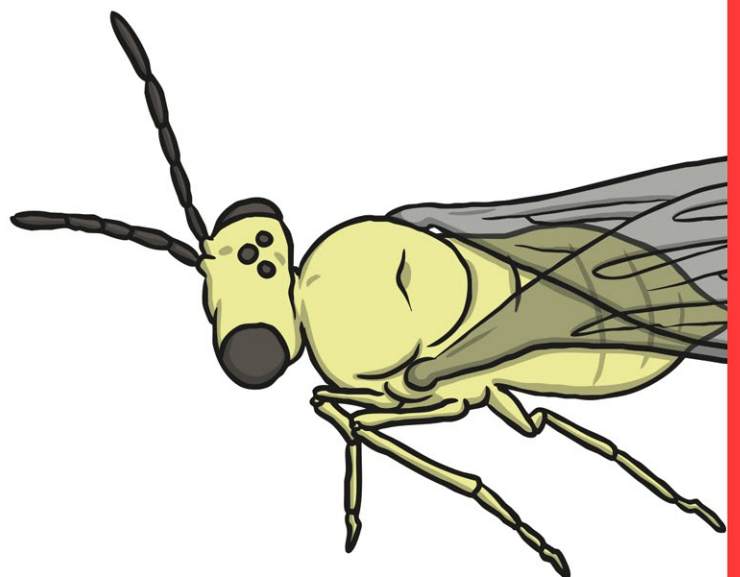
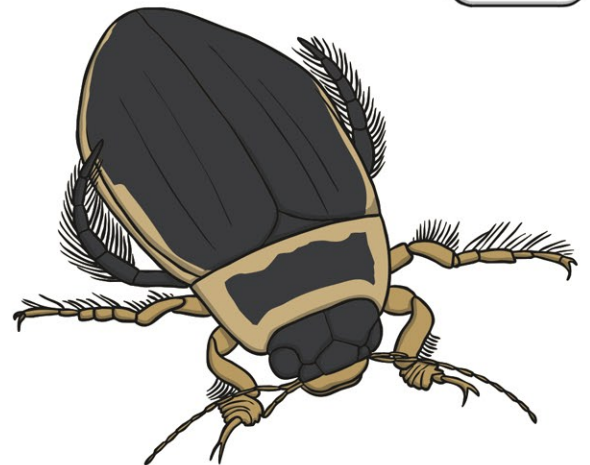
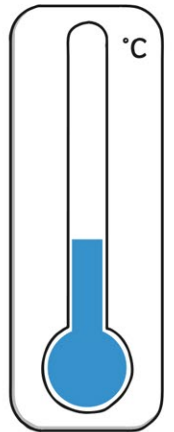
Have two antennae.

Live in colonies.

Most hatch from eggs.

A spider is not an insect.

Have 6 legs.



Arthropod

Are cold blooded.

Are invertebrate (without a spine)

A segmented body (with more than one part)

About 85% of all animals are arthropods, including spiders, insects and crustacean.
